WHAT IS THE TUNE NETWORK

TUNE is a transnational network in Europe and consists from 18 partner organizations from 16 countries.

The United Societies of Balkans is the coordinator of the project.

The project is created to initiate the creation of an EU-wide Network of 18 youth organisations who share the values of empowering youth to be active citizens in democratic life, promotion of voluntarism and social inclusion with support of Erasmus+ and other EU programs.



No. 1

Strengthen youth work on the local level by providing activities for organisations to build capacity, develop sustainability, form local consortiums, share knowledge and disseminate good practices.

No. 2

Establish efficient, sustainable partnerships and structure for exchange of good practices, competences, information and insights between 18 youth organisations that will be a firm starting point for creating new joint projects and long lasting cooperation.

No. 3

Empower young people to achieve their fullest potential as active citizens by informing them about Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps as programmes that support their personal, social and professional development.



Latest activities of the network until December 2023

54 Info days in each participant country

Each partner in the network organized three Erasmus+ Info Days in each participating country, attended by over 1155 young people. Throughout the year until December 2023, each organization organized a total of 3 Info Days, resulting in 54 events in 16 countries! These events informed youth about EU Youth policy and goals but also aimed to make mobility opportunities more equally accessible.

Video spots: Experiences with Erasmus+ in the member countries of the TUNE network

23 videos were created by the 18 different organizations from the 16 countries of the network. The short videos show what and how young people learn about different aspects of the EU through the Erasmus+ program, via ESC opportunities, youth exchanges and training initiatives. In each country of the network, a young representative talks about their experiences in less than a minute and presents the different encounters in an engaging way. 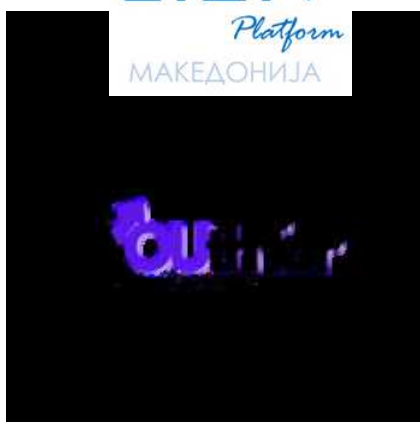
TUNE General Assembly and Networking Event, 6-8 December 2023, Thessaloniki

The TUNE General Assembly and networking event in Thessaloniki brought together the 18 organizations of the network from 16 countries. Together, they agreed on the network's strategic plan for the next two years. The discussions focused on three important pillars: Sustainability, Stakeholder Engagement and Dissemination. Using the World Café method, all members jointly defined the guidelines for the network's future path.
